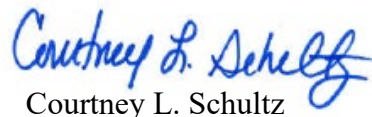

RATE SCHEDULE NO. 6
RESILIENCY AND ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEM INVESTMENT CHARGE (“RESIC”)

APPLICABILITY:

The following RESIC rates, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 48:2-21 and N.J.S.A. 48:19-29, et seq., are applicable to the use of water service for all General Metered Service Customers and Private Fire Sprinkler Connections served by the Company. The RESIC is designed to recover project costs associated with investments in certain non-revenue producing water system components that are in direct or indirect compliance with requirements addressing existing or emerging requirements; as well as investments to enhance water system resiliency, and the health, safety or environmental protection of customers, employees, or the public.

RATE:

All General Metered Service customers and Private Fire Sprinkler Connections served by the Company shall pay a fixed charge as indicated below.

10”	115.0	148.35

*Based on American Water Works Association flow rates. A 5/8-inch meter is equivalent to one unit, whereas a 1-inch meter is equivalent to 2.5 units based on the amount of water that will flow through the meter size.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

PAYMENT FOR ALL BILLS RENDERED IS DUE TWENTY (20) DAYS AFTER THE ORIGINAL POSTMARK DATE OF THE BILL. The RESIC is assessed monthly for metered service, and is reflected on the Customer’s bill rendered at the close of the billing period.
